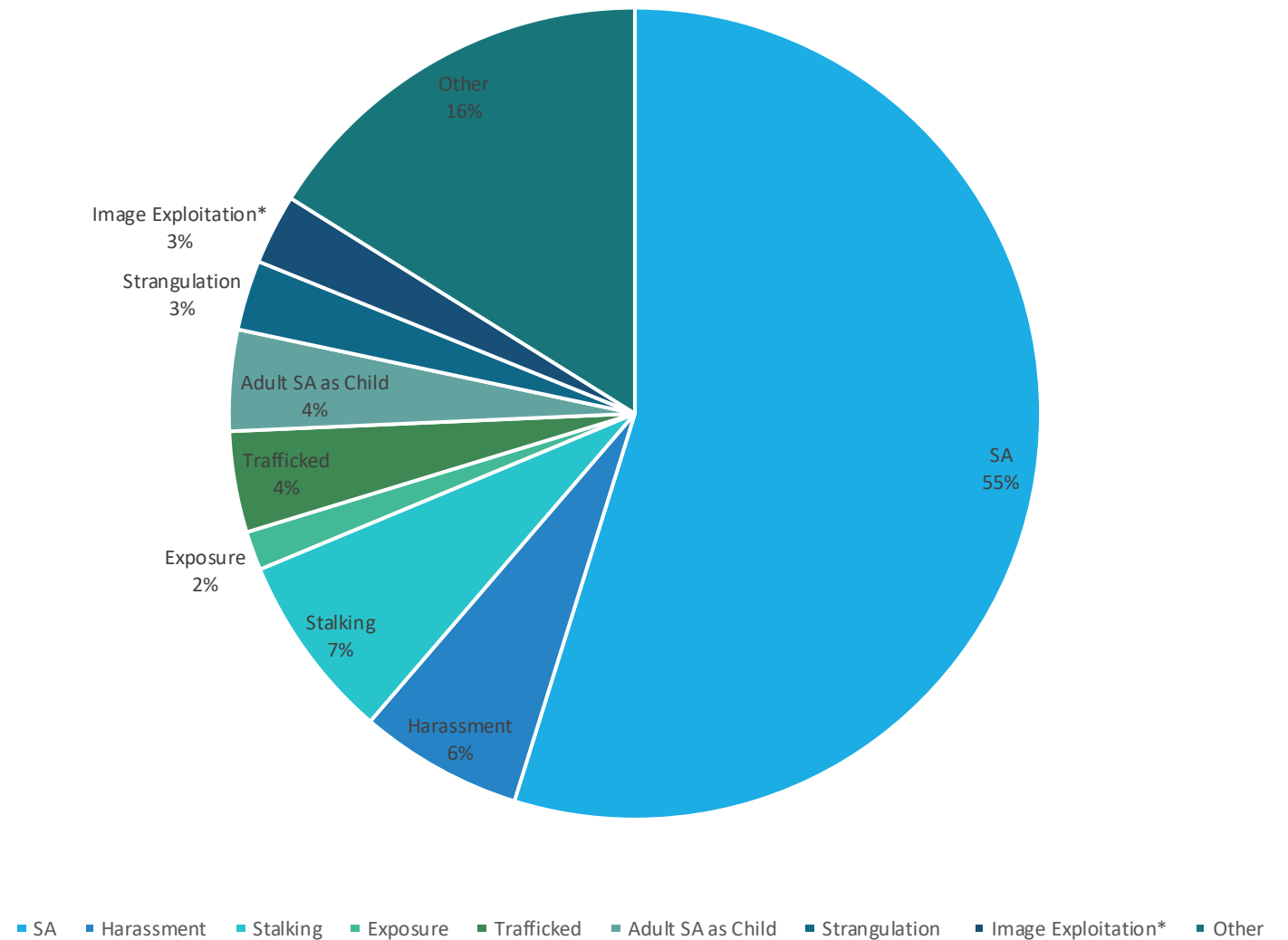

SASSMM Clients - Types of Abuse Experienced

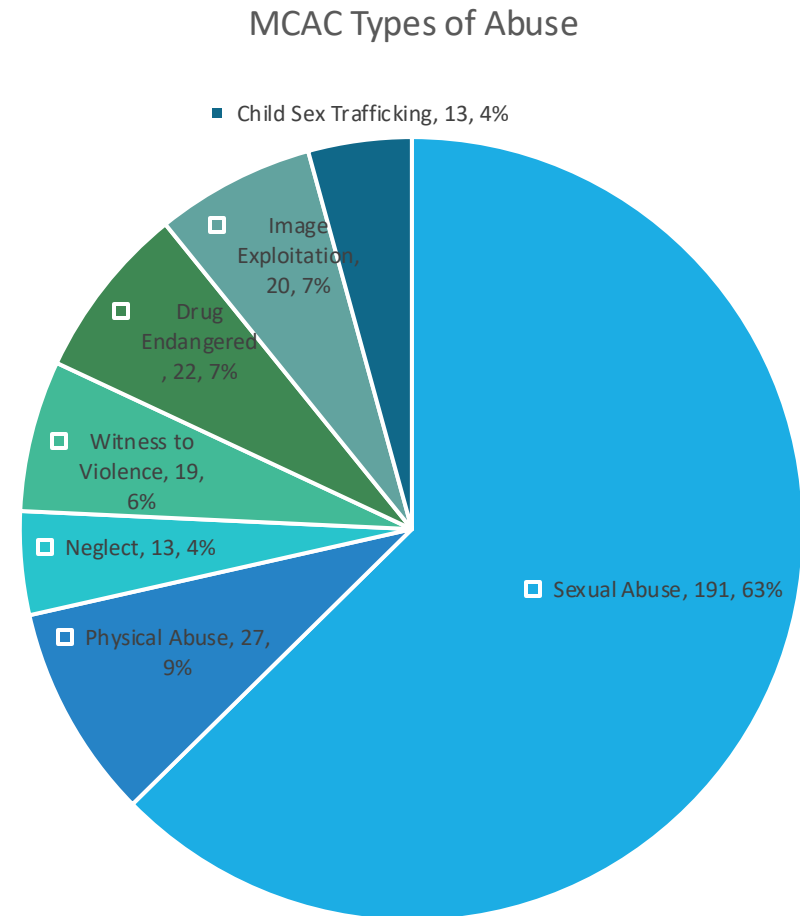
In FY25, the most common type of assault experienced for our non-Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) clients was sexual assault.

Our CAC clients were primarily referred for sexual abuse. We also saw more cases in FY25 for image exploitation

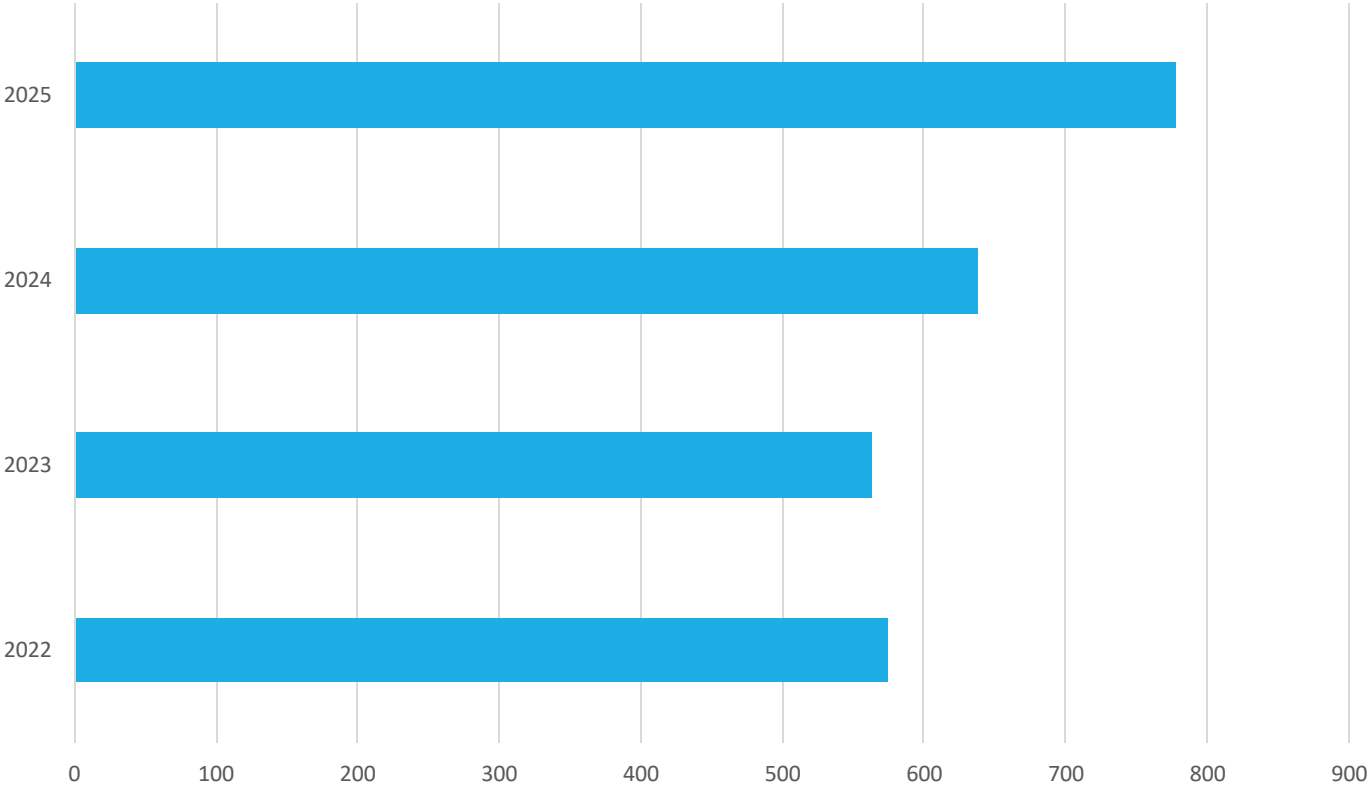


FY25 SASSMM SERVICES

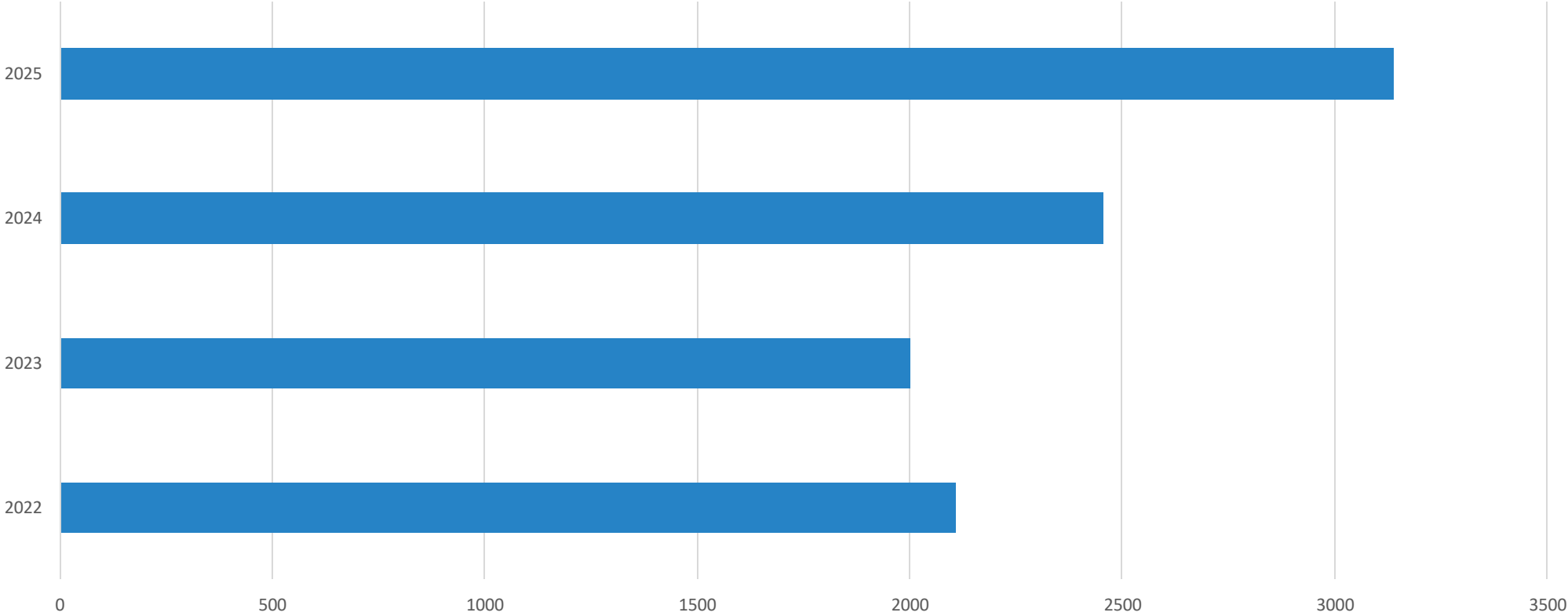


We saw a 22% increase in clients in 2025.

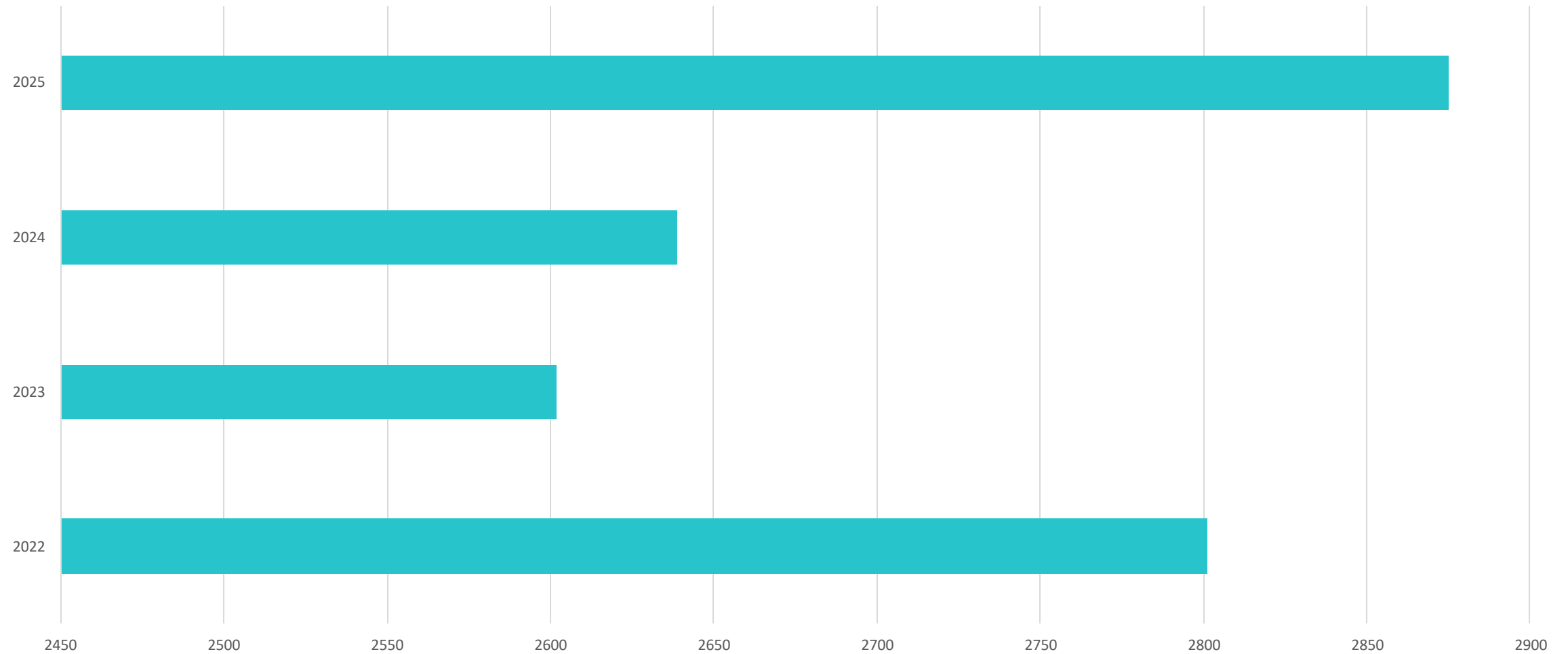

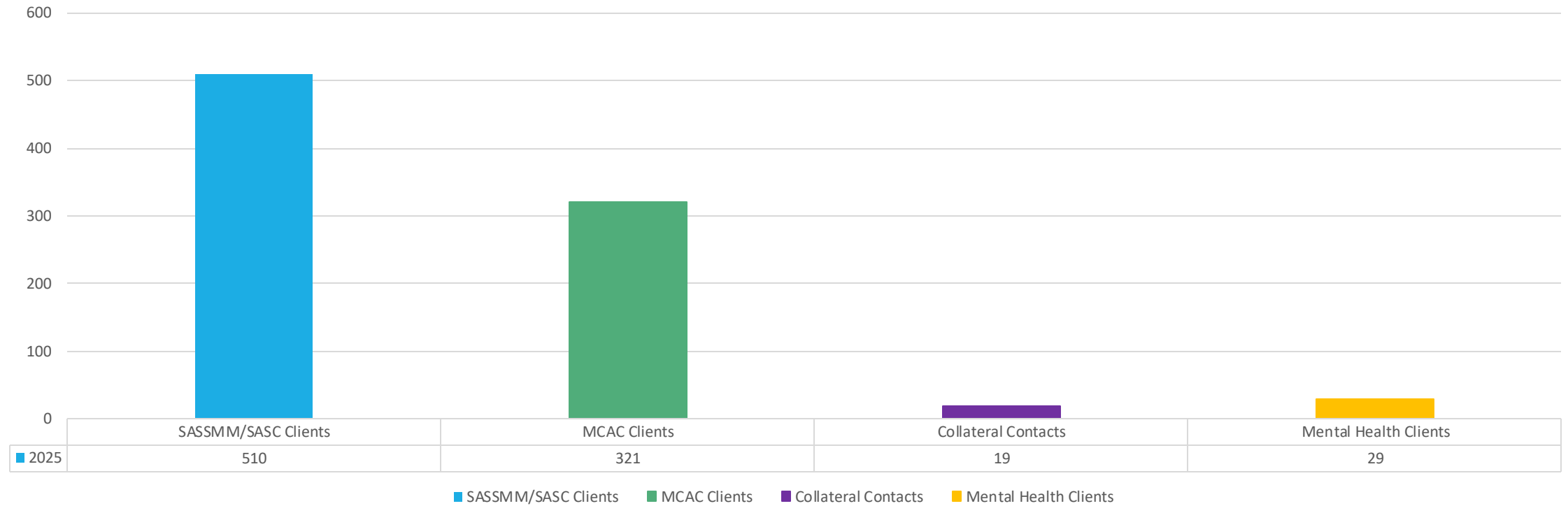

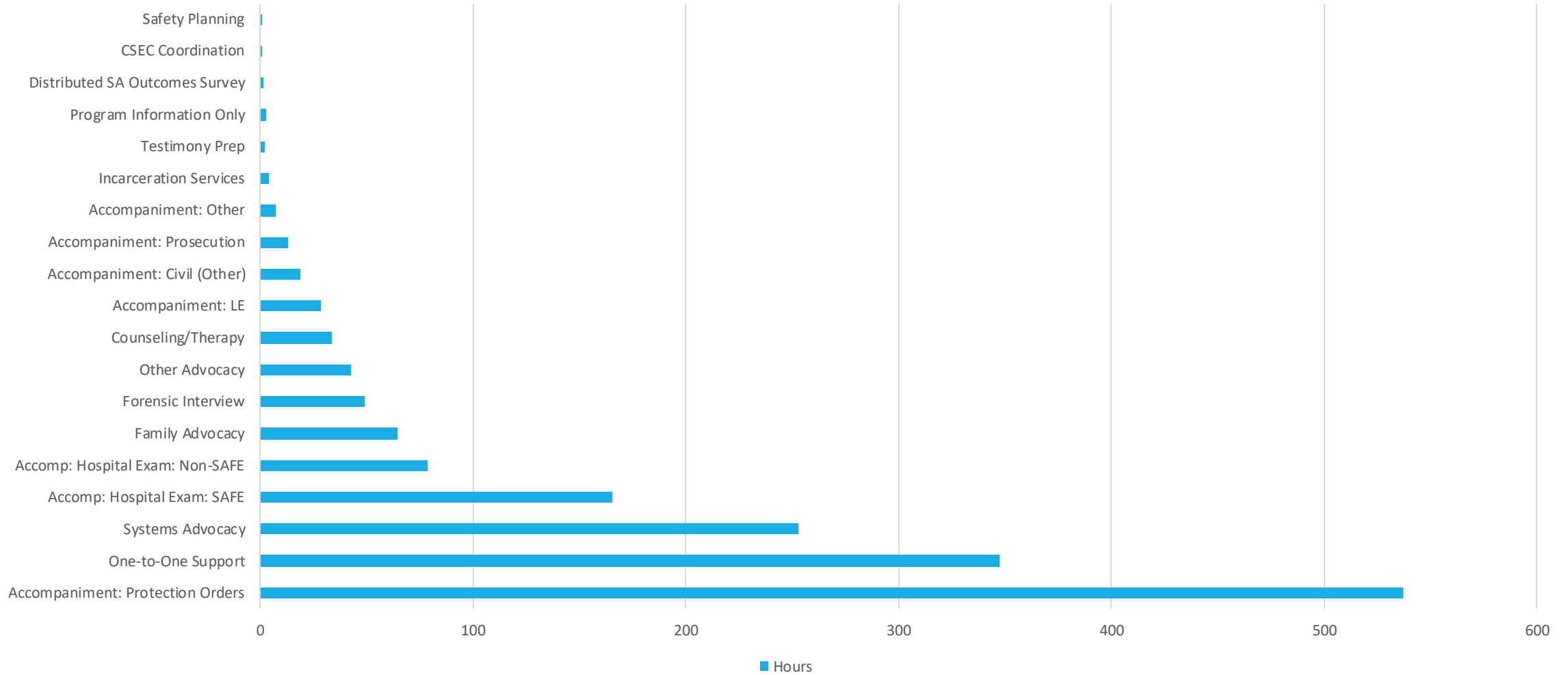

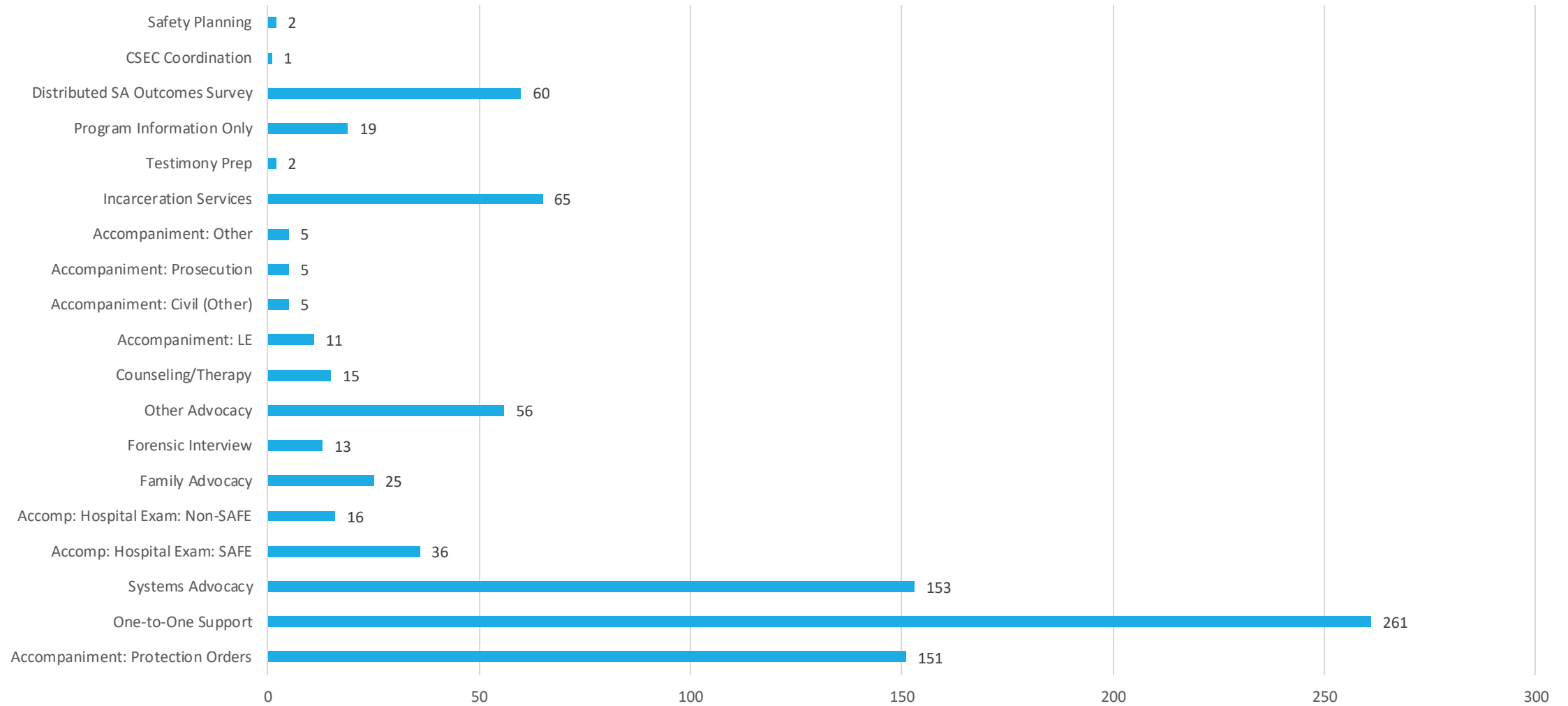

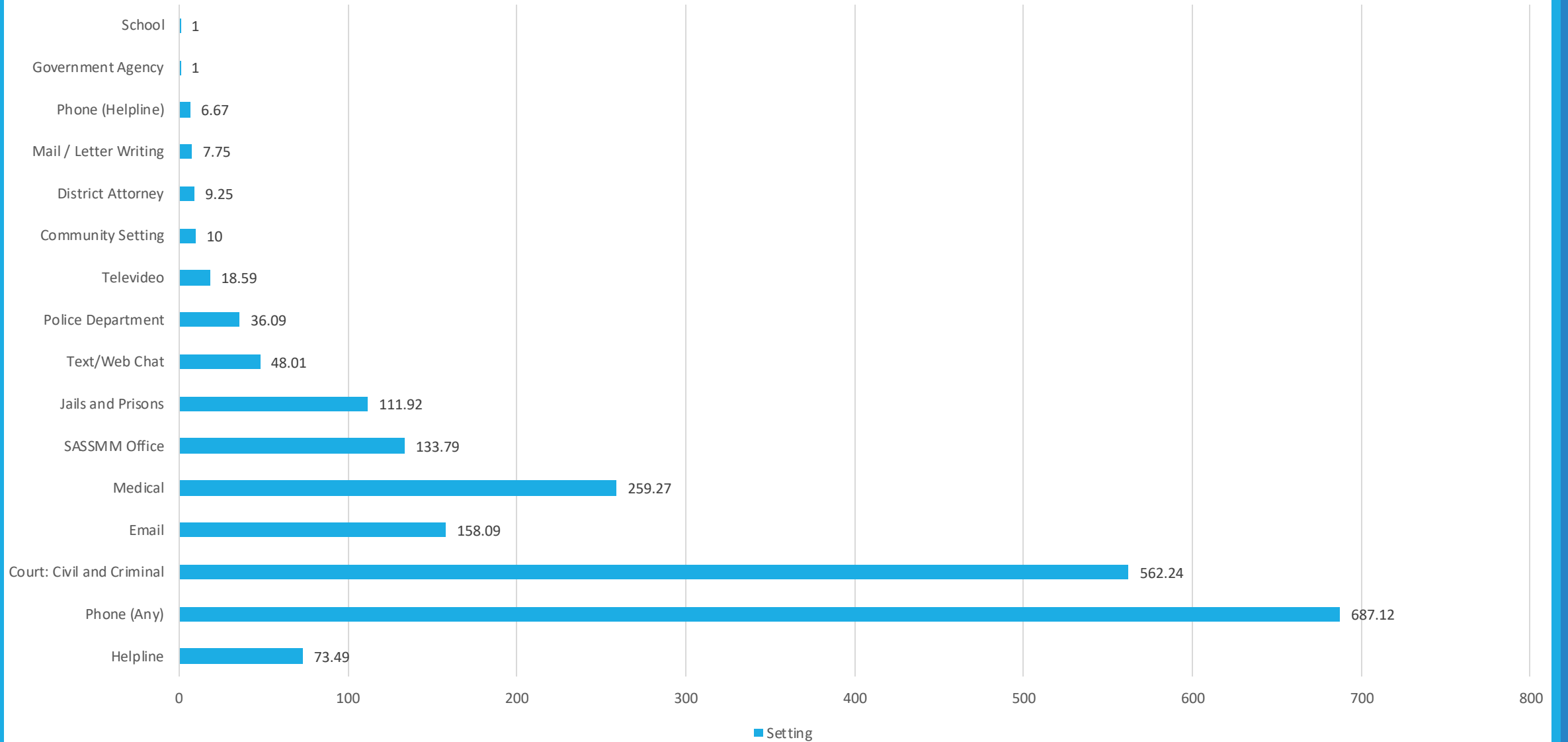


Services by Hour

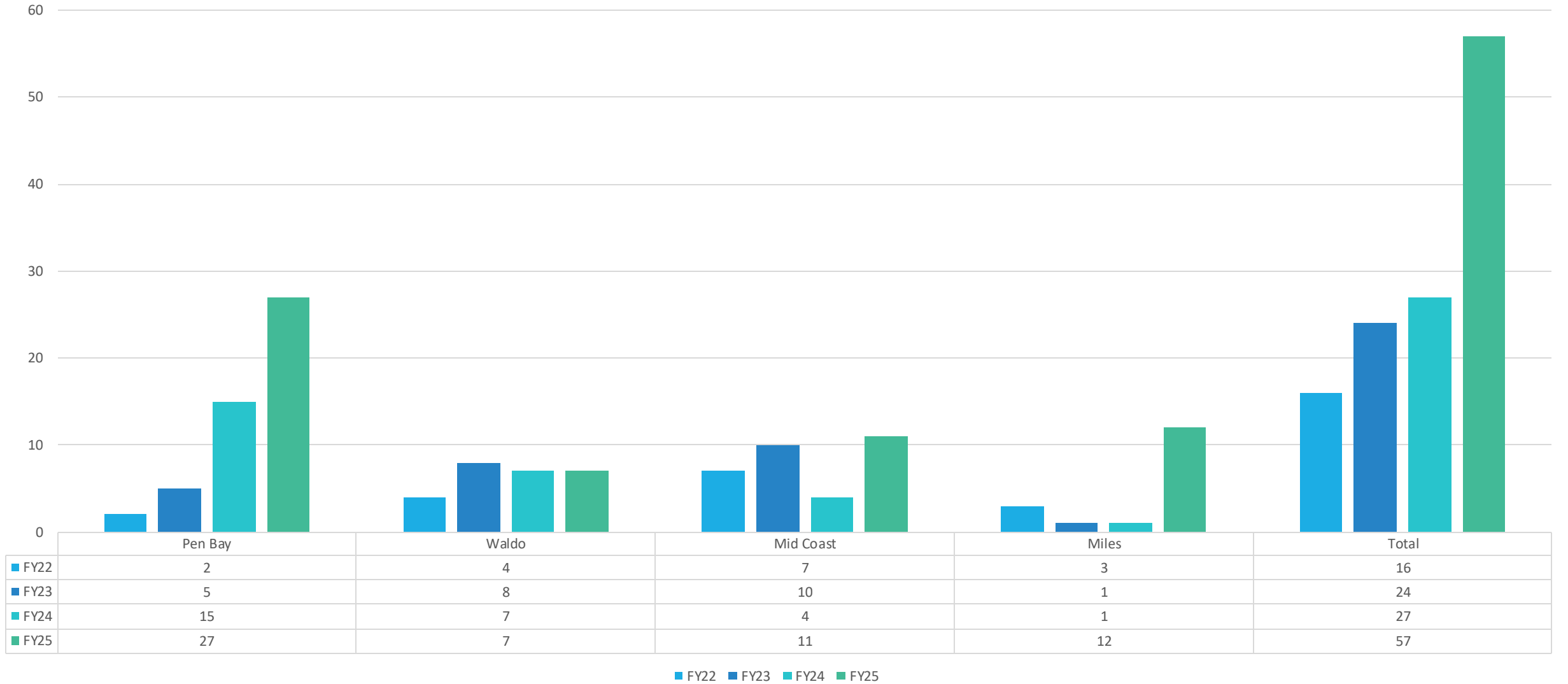


Services by Clients

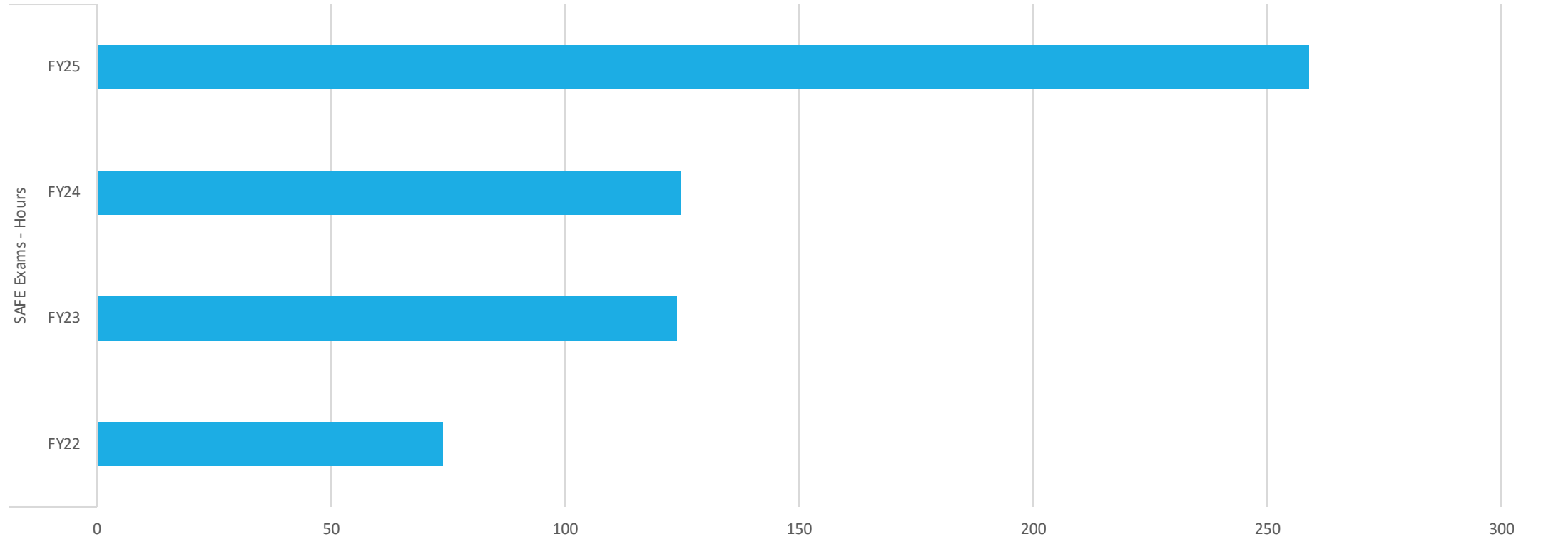


SAFE Exams by Location

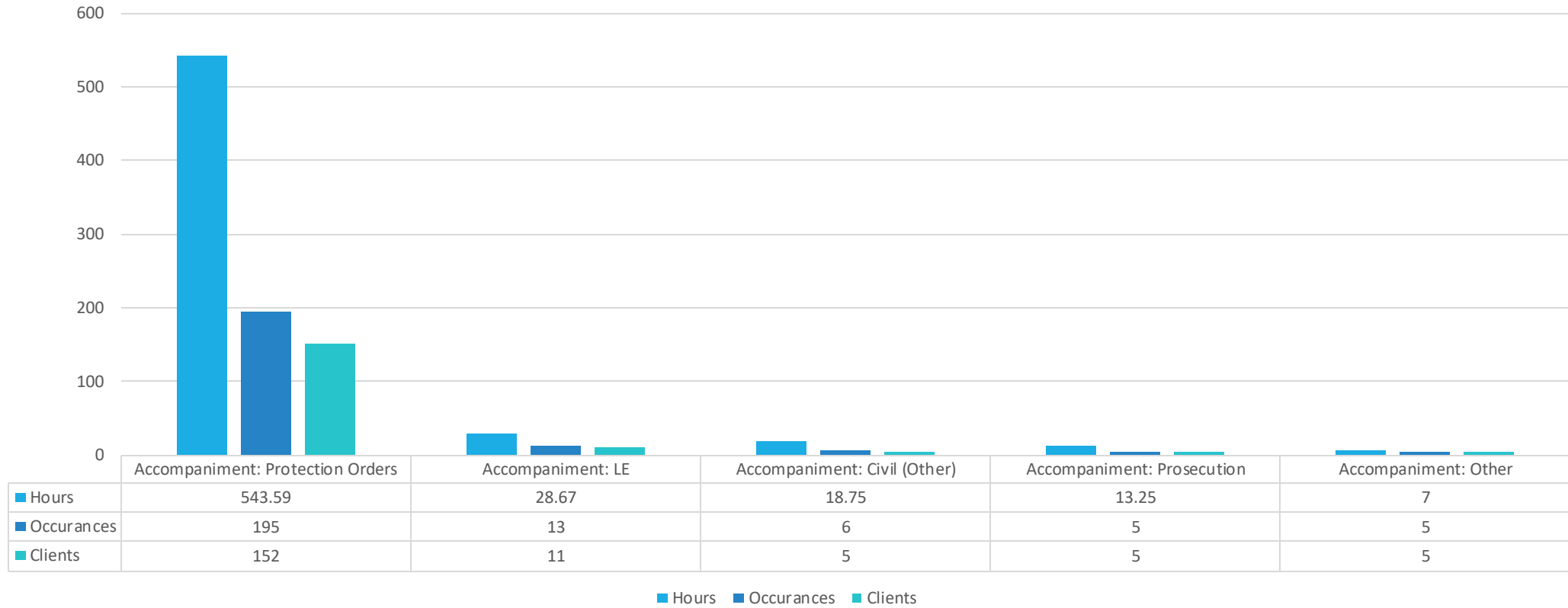


Service Locations – Hospitals/SAFEs

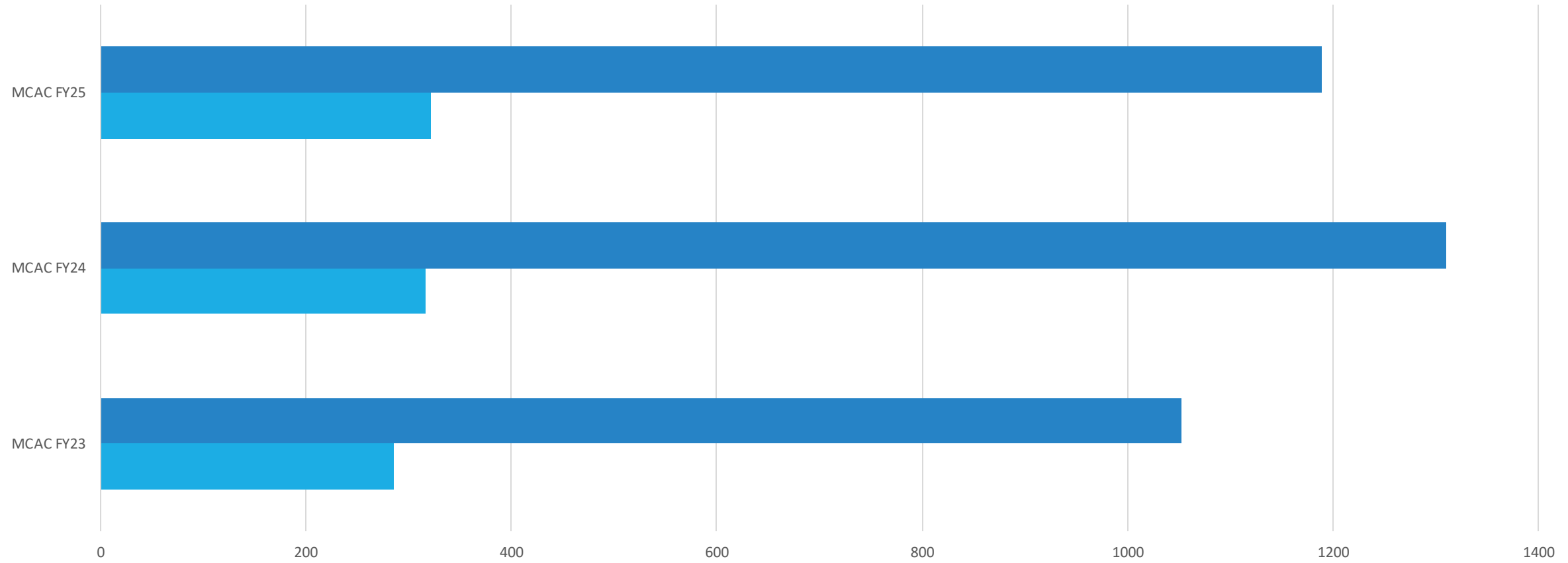

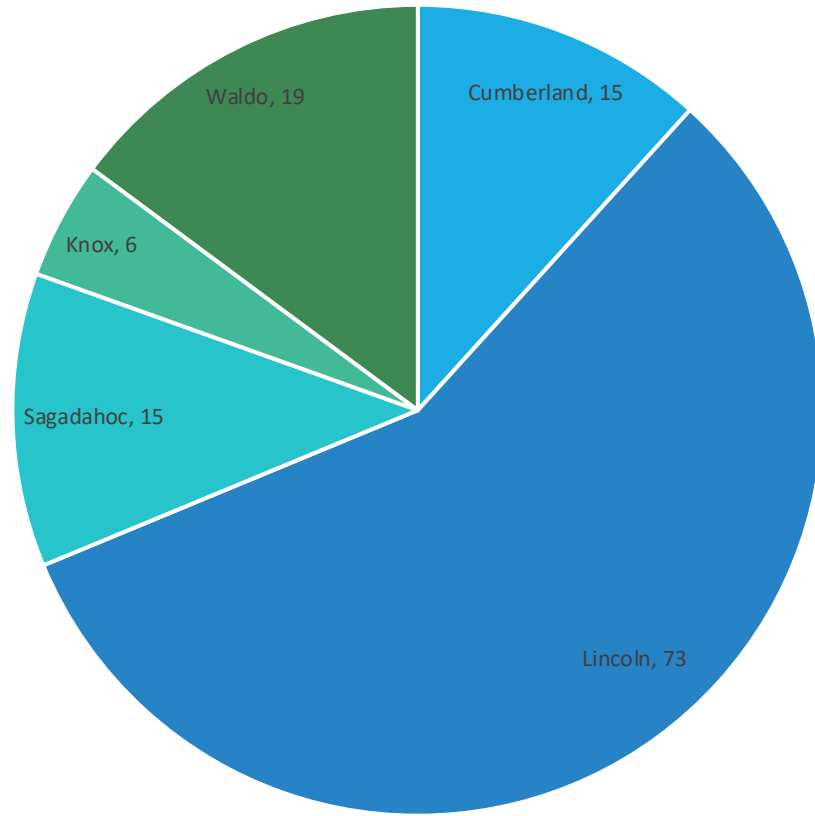
